[科目の概要] <p>Essay writing in English may be different not only from essay writing in Japanese, but even from other writing in English. This course is designed to take college-level students with an intermediate ability in English as a foreign language from paragraph writing through essay writing. During this course, students will have many opportunities to learn how to organize topics, write cohesive paragraphs, and organize them into clear, logical expository compositions. The focus throughout is on academic writing — the type of writing used in college courses and exams in English-speaking institutions of higher learning.</p> <p>この授業では、英文パラグラフの構造を学び、paragraph writing から Essay writing へ繋がります。</p>

During this course, students will have opportunities to study and discuss examples of English academic writing. Students will also have many opportunities to discuss their own writing and the writing of their classmates. Additionally, students will learn how important the reader is to the writer and how to express clearly and directly what you mean to communicate.
