[科目の概要] <p>English Presentation I is intended for low-intermediate students and focuses on giving presentations about everyday experiences. The aim of this course is to offer students an opportunity to develop the important life skill of speaking clearly and effectively about a topic of interest to an audience. Through this course, student can learn and practice some effective ways to give English presentations. Additionally, this course also covers other issues like body language, visuals, specific structures and how to describe graphs or charts.
