〔科目の概要〕 The primary objective of the module is to guide students to attain a reasonable level of competency in writing and delivering a presentation. Students will engage in meaningful practises through class tasks and/or exercises to study various strategies used in presentations, identify, and analyse sample presentations, and how to apply them. Furthermore, they will learn that public speaking or presentation is not simply a one-way sharing of information but a two-way reciprocal exchange of information where both the speaker and audience are equally involved. The final project will involve the production and delivery of a presentation on a topic of their own choosing. Please be aware that the module is taught almost entirely in English, hence it is ideal for students at an intermediate to high-intermediate level of English.

Proficiency in public speaking/presentation is a valuable skill in this day and age, given its wide-ranging applications in personal, professional, and social settings. During the course of the module, students are expected to work individually, in pairs, or in groups (where possible), to simulate a professional work environment in order to engage in teamwork exercises – an essential skill that is sort after by employees. They will analyse sample speeches/presentations, PowerPoint slides, and how to apply them in one’s own speech/presentation
